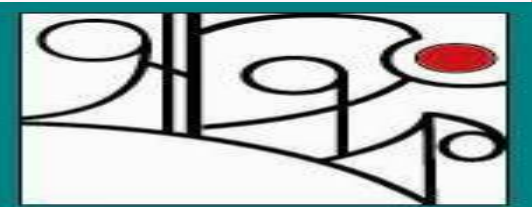
1. April 17– Electing committee for the next financial year and celebrating Bengali New year.
